If you have many children to collect, they will all be leaving at the time of your youngest child. So if your youngest child is in Grade Prep all your children will be dismissed at 1:30pm. As always if you need to collect your child earlier you will need to call the school to arrange this as the gates will be locked until 1:25pm.

Please be on time to collect your child/children, we also need you to remember to adhere to social distancing rules whilst waiting to collect your child.
