Dear Parents and Carers,

Following advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, the Victorian Government has advised that schools can return to on-site schooling as of today Wednesday 28th July.

To support the health and wellbeing of all our students and staff, our school will implement a range of COVID safe measure. This includes

- staggered starts and finishes for students, the times are outlined below
- no visitors onsite
- no assemblies, events or gatherings,
- all staff and parents must wear a face mask
- frequent hand washing and good hygiene practices.

If your child is ill or is feeling unwell, they must not attend school. They must remain home and until they are well. If any member of your family has symptoms of COVID-19 they must get tested and stay home until you get the results.

While the Victorian Chief Health Officer has advised that students will not be required to maintain physical distancing at school, there will be a number of important changes to our school operations, consistent with health advice. This will apply until further notice.

Food

It is advisable for all children to bring their lunch with them in the morning. Food is not to be shared. The canteen will be open for lunch orders only on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Staggered Start and Break Times

Parents will need to leave their child/children at the school gate. Staff will be there to sanitize their hands, on arrival at school.

Parents/carers must obey social distancing rules at drop off and pick up times.

During the school day, there will be staggered recess and lunch breaks to minimise the number of students and staff in the playgrounds and in contact with each other.
