- To provide a safe friendly space that fosters sharing of knowledge, ideas and experiences amongst parents, school staff and wider community agencies
- To provide a welcoming space for parents to learn from each other and to learn new skills.

Implementation

The school's Community Hub will provide

- A welcoming space for parents to meet other parents/carers of the school
- Facilitate parent programs
- English classes
- Education in Australia – English, Maths information
- Run information sessions on subjects parents/carers have requested
- Craft activities
- Kinda Kinder playgroup
- Cooking sessions with parents
- Fitness activities such as Zumba
- Computer classes
